Key Metrics

Clean Power Plan

- Flexible
- By 2030:
 - 32% less carbon pollution
 - 90% less SO₂
 - 72% less NO_x
- Avoids thousands of premature deaths and hospital admissions, tens of thousands of asthma attacks, and hundreds of thousands of school and work days missed
- Hundreds of stakeholder meetings
- 4.3M public comments

Ozone Standard

- 70 ppb
- CDC - 6.1M children have asthma
- By 2025:
 - Avoids 230,000 asthma attacks in children
 - Avoid 160,000 missed school days
 - Avoids 340 cases of acute bronchitis in children
 - Benefits \$2.9-\$5.9 billion annually
